Important Information

ADDITIONAL TAX INFORMATION: Various city councils in Europe have introduced a new accommodation/city tax to generate additional revenue for the improvement of services and infrastructure offered to the tourist. New cities are constantly adopting these measures and the amount of the tax varies from country to country and city to city.

The amount of the tax is based on the cost and number of stars of the hotel (from 3 Euros per person per day for a 3* hotel to possibly 10 Euros per person per day for a 5* property.)

Although our packages include the European VAT (Value Added Tax), this accommodation tax is to be paid by the GUEST directly to the hotel before the end of the stay and cannot be prepaid. It is then remitted directly to the city council by the hotels.

TRANSFER INSTRUCTIONS & LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS:

- If you are having difficulty locating the driver, then please call the number(s) noted on the itinerary for the local Supplier.
- Leaving your pick-up location without notifying the Local Supplier will result in a "No-Show" charge.
- Transfer vehicles can accommodate 1 suitcase and 1 small carry-on bag per person.
- Any excess luggage is subject to space availability. Additional costs may result and will be the sole responsibility of the traveler.

GRATUITIES: While gratuities are not mandatory in Europe, we do recommend them if clients have been happy with the services, drivers and tour guides as goodwill token of appreciation.

DRESS CODE GUIDELINES

Access to museums, churches and holy places is only permitted to visitors dressed appropriately (no sleeveless blouses, no miniskirts, no hats, no flip-flops allowed)

Important Tips For Visiting Italy

- For tours of churches and the Vatican, knees and shoulders must be covered. Women may want to bring a light scarf that can be tied around their shoulders while wearing tank tops or sundresses.
- In most major cities, you will owe city taxes of 2 to 8 euros per person/per night, paid locally at the hotel directly.
- Please be aware that Italy is notorious for pickpockets. Especially if you are visiting Rome or Naples, please make sure to keep all wallets, purses, and cameras secured when out and about. In major cities, we highly recommend using a money belt tucked inside your clothes.
- TRAIN RESERVATIONS: It is important to note, that your destination for each train is not necessarily the final destination of the train. So, when you search for the platform number ("binario") on the departures board at the station, you will need to look for the train number that corresponds to the ticket for each journey. Then go to the platform that is listed for that train. Finally, once you are on the train, make sure to watch for your stop and be ready with your bags to get off the train. Some trains only stop briefly. Station names are listed as the Italian name such as "Roma" rather than Rome, so make sure to read your ticket and watch for the Italian station name so you don't miss your stop.
- If you are visiting Venice (Venezia), make sure that you get off at the correct train stop that matches your tickets. There are 2 stops, Venezia S. Luci and Venezia Mestre.
- Consider bringing bug spray if you are visiting the Italian countryside such as Tuscany.
